Diesel classes will be broken down according to the number and type of modifications (K, KK, L, LL, M, MM). Class changes may be made depending on the number and type of entries to ensure even competition.

General Rules - Sublimity Harvest Festival reserves the right to accept or reject any entries

- 1. Contest is a non-sanctioned, all-comers event, open to the general public for the sole purpose of entertainment.
- 2. No secondary fuels, No exotic fuels (No NOS on any vehicle, No propane injection on Diesel) Primary fuel only, Pump gas, Pump diesel, and Propane, only as a primary fuel.
- 3. ALL DRIVERS MUST WEAR HELMET. Seat belts must be worn at all times during the pull.
- 4. Drivers only. No passengers allowed in vehicle on track.
- 5. All vehicles and drivers must be weighed and pass a technical inspection, after which the vehicle is placed into a weight class. Then, the vehicles are driven to the staging area, where absolutely no weight shifts, vehicle alterations, or driver changes may be made.
- 6. All weights must be securely fastened to the vehicle No loose weights in the cab or bed.
- 7. Weights can measure no more than 42" forward from the center line of the front axle. (7,000 lbs. & up: 60")
- 8. All contestants must attend a driver's and judge's meeting prior to the start of the contest.
- 9. ALL Drawbars will be inspected at tech inspection.
- 10. Drawbar must be stationary in all directions, Maximum height shall be 24 inches from the hitch parallel to the ground. The drawbar MUST have a minimum of 1-inch hole for attaching the sled.
- 11. Solid suspension will be placed in the Super Stock class, regardless of engine modification or lack thereof.
- 12. Engine modifications may place you in the Super Stock class. Gas classes are allowed two external modifications. Any internal modifications will place you into Super Stock. Engine swaps may place you into Super Stock. For diesel classes, any emissions deleting or tuning will place you in Super Stock. The final decision will be made by our judges.
- 13. Cut / non-DOT tires will automatically place you into Super Stock regardless of engine modifications or lack thereof.
- 14. The contest is governed by a panel of judges, with all decisions final. Judges & track crew have the right to stop and disqualify ANY CONTESTANT operating a vehicle in an unsafe manner.
- 15. Weight classes subject to change without notice
- 16. No Tolerance for Alcohol or Drugs in the pit, staging, track, or parking areas. If any driver or crew member is found in possession or under the influence of such, you will be immediately disqualified and removed from the pit! No Refunds! No Exceptions! Your safety and the safety of our spectators is our main concern. Thank you for your cooperation.

We will run the first 100 entries through the gate, first come, first served!
